### The problems ...

#### Confined areas and vertical surfaces

Removing multiple coats of hardened, discolored floor finish can be a challenging job under ideal circumstances. But, if the build-up is behind a toilet, under a church pew, beneath a drinking fountain or on baseboards or stair risers, the job becomes a lot tougher. Accumulations easily removed with a good stripper, a floor machine and a stripping pad in a few minutes can take hours of manual scrubbing in a problem area.

### Liquid strippers and foaming aerosols ...

#### Not the answer

Today's re-emulsifying strippers work great on normal accumulations, on level floors, and open areas. But, they tend to evaporate in a few minutes, so heavy build-ups in corners or edges can require several applications before they break through ... assuming the floor is level so the stripper does not run off and pool where it is not needed. A waste of time and product. **Not the answer.**



### PASS ... The solution

PASS is a new generation, re-emulsifying stripper formulated with a unique jelling agent that controls evaporation and allows targeted application to problem areas. It clings to vertical surfaces and dissolves heavy accumulations with a minimum of manual scrubbing. Inaccessible areas, caked with 25-30 coats of discolored finish can be soak stripped with a single application ... without run-off or puddling. **PASS ... the answer.**
